VR-1 Training Reactor Technical Visit

Conditions of technical visit:

1. Technical visits to the reactor are aimed mainly at High school or University students.
2. Only persons older than 18ys can enter into the facility. In case of high school students visits, they must be older than 16ys.
3. Maximum number of visitors for one entry is 30.
4. Entry to reactor hall is not allowed for pregnant women, it is strictly forbidden to carry weapons and explosives.
5. In the reactor hall is not allowed to use mobile phones or other comware.
6. Before the technical visit it is necessary to fill „*Visitors list*“. For detailed info see *Technical visit preparation*.
7. Correctly filled Visitors list has to be sent by fax or by email (PDF. format) at least 2 working days before the technical visit.
8. Each visitor must be stated on the Visitors list and he/she is obliged to have ID (same as on list) ready for a check. Before entry the check will be carried and only people complying with the regulation will be allowed to enter the site.

Technical visit preparation

1. Read carefully *Conditions of technical visit* (see above)
2. Technical visits are not a primary activity at the VR-1 Reactor, therefore it is necessary to arrange them well in advance. The technical visits usually start at 9.00 AM or 01.00 PM.
3. Dates of technical visits may be arranged at email: exkurze@reaktorvr1.eu
4. Detailed instructions will be sent to you in case of empty time slots.

Technical visit organisation:

1. Before entry, visitors are instructed about conditions of being in contained area and protected area of the reactor, and then their ID is checked. Visitors confirm by signature a voluntary enter and sign up to adhere the entry conditions.
2. Group of visitors will be equipped by personal dosimeters, overalls and overshoes.
3. A visit takes about 1.5 – 2 hours, including check-in and check-out
4. Before leaving , visitors will be checked for contamination, return the dosimeters and wash their hands.

How to reach us:

By public transportation: Metro C (red) line – stop „Nadrazi Holesovice“, then bus no. 102 or 186 to stop „Kuchynka“

By car: from Holešovice follow the Argentinska street in the direction of the Barikadniku bridge. Just behind the bridge, go to the right in the direction of the ZOO. Cross the crossroad towards the high glass building located close to the crossroad.

These conditions are valid since 1 March 2008
